- **Background:** Founded in 1993, Community Health Partnership (CHP) is a consortium of 10 nonprofit community health centers that serve 170,000 patients per year and an additional 70,000 patients in behavioral health.
- **Our Vision:** We believe in affordable, accessible, and quality patient-centered health care for all of Santa Clara and San Mateo Counties' residents.
- **Our Mission:** To advocate for affordable and accessible health services for our diverse and multicultural communities regardless of socioeconomic, ethnic, religious, or cultural background, and to support our member organizations in achieving these goals.

Program Overview:

- Every Woman Counts (EWC) is a State program of the California Department of Health Care Service's Cancer Detection and Treatment Branch (CDTB).
- EWC provides clinical breast exams, mammograms, pelvic exams, and Pap tests to California's underserved women. The mission of EWC is to save lives by preventing and reducing the devastating effects of cancer for Californians through education, early detection, diagnosis and treatment.
- CHP is a regional contractor of the EWC program serving four counties in the Central Coast: Santa Clara, San Benito, Santa Cruz, and Monterey.
- The EWC maintains a network of diverse primary care providers, and coordinates tailored breast and cervical cancer health education and outreach to eligible women in each county.

Position Summary:

We are seeking a Community Health Worker (CHW) to join our team in providing breast and cervical cancer screening education and outreach in the Black/African American community within Santa Clara County. Under supervision, the CHW will assist in educating rarely or never screened individuals in Santa Clara County and as needed, in Santa Cruz, San Benito and Monterey Counties, about breast and cervical cancer early detection and informing individuals about free screening services to those who are eligible.

Key responsibilities:

- Teach EWC health education curriculum (training provided)
- Distribute EWC resources and health education material at outreach events and health fairs.
- Conduct EWC follow-up communication.
- Facilitate the location and promotion of EWC health education classes and community events.

Requirements:

- Must reside in and share experience, languages and/or culture of the community to be served.
- Ability to assist and promote programs, including be well connected with Black/African American communities and spaces.
- Must be outgoing, assertive and passionate about community health.
- Must have 1-2 years of experience in community health, health services and/or equivalent education or skills.
- Strong planning and organization skills with proven ability to work effectively both independently and on a team.
- Basic computer skills including email and Microsoft software applications.
- Ability to work flexible and on-call schedules.
- Must have access to transportation and be willing to travel throughout Santa Clara County
- Valid California driver's license, access to a vehicle, and proof of liability insurance
- High school diploma or GED, preferred (not required)

- Promote health and health care services

Salary and Benefits:

- This position is subcontract, part-time with flexible hours, starting at 34.75 hours per fiscal year.
